Overview

On arrival at Windhoek International Airport, you will be collected with a luxury minibus and transferred to Namutoni Camp, inside the Etosha National Park. This will be the base for your Etosha Photographic Safari. Lunch, and an afternoon game drive will be dependent on your arrival time. The rest of your safari will include photography in the early mornings, to return to camp for a late brunch. Between the morning and afternoon game drives you will have ample time to download and evaluate the day's images. You will receive daily professional editing and workshop support. If you so wish, a full day's photographic outing to the waterholes can be arranged.

The Etosha National Park has an abundance of wildlife! In the winter months the wildlife congregates in large numbers at the life giving waterholes. On this safari, you will have the opportunity to photograph at two exclusive waterholes - normally reserved for the BBC's and National Geographic's of this world.

The custom designed long wheel base safari vehicles are equipped with only three world-class photographic chairs per vehicle, which allows for lots of space and a photographic experience to none! Of all the Southern African photographic destinations where one must photograph from a vehicle, the Etosha National Park comes the closest to equalling Chobe National Park's photographic boat based safaris.
